What does 'unapplied', 'unlinked', and or 'uncategorized' mean in Jackrabbit?

These terms are used to indicate when a payment and a fee are not linked with a <u>Category 1</u>. Jackrabbit relies on linking fees and payments to ensure accurate revenue reporting. Fees are assigned <u>Category 1</u> names; and when payments are made, the payment is applied (or linked) to a fee. The payment takes on the <u>Category 1</u> of the fee it is applied to and Jackrabbit groups it with other payments that have the same <u>Category 1</u>. When a payment is not linked, it has <u>No Category and is considered uncategorized or unapplied.</u> When a fee is not linked to a payment, we generally refer to it as <u>unlinked</u>.
