Time and Date Settings are very important in Jackrabbit and should not be skipped during your Getting Started set up.

- 1. Go to Tools > Edit Settings > Organization Defaults > Time Date Settings.
- 2. Select the Date Format for your organization. Jackrabbit uses the US standard date format of mm/dd/yyyy throughout the database and it is not possible at this time to use another format inside the database. You can, however, choosedd/mm/yyyy for external (customer) views such as on the Web Registration form: student birth date or on customer statements.
- 3. Verify your **Time Zone** to ensure that all financial transactions and enrollment records use your area's correct date and time.

Note: Jackrabbit defaults to Eastern Time - US/Canada if this setting is not changed.

- 4. Verify the dates if you observe daylight savings time and update if needed.
- 5. Click **Save Changes** on the upper left of the page.
